The Council met at a special meeting on November 7, 2025 at 4:30 pm, at the Craigmont Fire Station.

A motion was made to go into executive session pursuant to Idaho Code sec. 74-206 (1) (f) to communicate with legal counsel for the City public agency to discuss the legal ramifications of and legal options concerning controversies not yet being litigated but imminently likely to be litigated by Councilmember Stigum and seconded by Councilmember Kevin, all in favor, M/C.

Council came out of executive session at 5:15 pm.

Councilmember Brown made a motion to authorize the city's attorney to respond to Leffingwells demands, including her reasonable accommodation request, by offering to waive the special use permit requirements under the city's zoning ordinances to allow Leffingwell to use the subject property as a certified family home without a special use permit. All other laws and city ordinances will still apply to the proposed use, including but not limited to building and fire codes. The City isn't offering to waive or do anything else at this time in response to Leffingwells demand, seconded by Councilmember Stigum, all in favor, M/C.

Motion was made by Councilmember Stigum to adjourn meeting at 5:30 pm, seconded by Brown, all in favor, M/C.
